**JOINING INSTRUCTIONS FOR PARTICIPANTS OF COURSES TO BE CONDUCTED AT THE  
CRPF ACADEMY, GURUGRAM, HARYANA**

**1. General**

CRPF Academy, Gurugram, is a premier institution of the country mandated with the task of imparting basic to the Directly Appointed Gazetted Officers (DAGOs) of the world largest Central Armed Force. The Centre Of Internal Security Studies(CISS) in the Academy has been designated as a “Centre of Excellence” and conducts various internal security courses for officers from CAPFs and State Police Forces. CRPF Academy came into existence on 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2002 when the foundation stone for the Academy was laid by the then Hon’ble Dy. Prime Minister and Home Minister Shri L.K. Advani. The CRPF Academy started functioning from 18<sup>th</sup> October 2005 when 187 officers of the 37<sup>th</sup> batch DAGOs joined the Academy for training. Since then 18 batches of DAGOs have passed out from this Academy. Prior to this, Basic Training of DAGOs was conducted at Internal Security Academy(ISA), Mount Abu, since 1976, and at Central Training College, Neemuch before that.

**2. About CRPF Academy.**

CRPF Academy is a melting pot of paramilitary tradition and sensitive policing where trainee officers undergo 52 weeks of intensive and grueling training. The Academy is an epitome for nurturing leadership, ethical conduct, patriotism and selfless service. The motto of the Academy is ‘Tejasvi Naavdheetmastu’ adopted from the Taitriya Upanishad which means ‘Let Brilliance Emerge from our Endeavours’.

The Academy campus is spread over 308 acres and nestled in the foothills of the Aravalis. Some of the salient features and facilities available at this Academy include:

- a. A full-fledged training and administrative block named Dronacharya Block.
- b. The Academy has a fully equipped Participant Hostel for the officers participating in the In Service Courses, and a separate DAGOs Hostel for officers undergoing Basic Training.
- c. Indoor Sports Complex comprising a fully equipped gymnasium, badminton courts, Squash Court, Billiards and TT tables, Sauna bath, Steam Bath and a Physio Hub.
- d. State of the art Dronacharya Full Bore Shooting Range upto 1000 yards range, and 25/50 Mtrs back to back Baffle Shooting Ranges.
- e. CRPF Museum showcasing the history, evolution, growth and legacy of CRPF.

- f. An Olympic size Swimming Pool, and an Environmental Park with a 18 hole golf course.
- g. A well-stocked library with a vast collection of books on all genres.
- h. A modern auditorium with seating capacity of 300 persons and having all amenities.
- i. A well maintained canteen consisting of KPKB, Café Academy, Co-Operative shop and CLMS.

3. **Climate.** The climate of Gurugram is akin to that of Delhi. The summers are very hot and winters are very cold. The temperature ranges from 45°C in the summer to 4<sup>0</sup> C in winter. The winters are marked by mist and fog in the morning. During March weather is pleasantly cool and temperature remains between 15°C- 25°C. The average rainfall is 553 mm.

#### 4. **Reception/Contact/Transport:**

- The Participants are required to intimate their travel plan i.e., mode, date and time of their arrival at CRPF Academy, Gurugram, well in advance for arranging reception and transportation.
- Transport will be provided by the Academy as per request at the nearest Airport/Railway station/bus stand on receipt of advance intimation regarding the date and time of arrival. Moreover, Participants are at liberty to book their own transportation at their own cost which they can get it reimbursed from their units/establishments as per the Govt. rules. Similarly, the return journey on completion of course to aforesaid places will be arranged by the Academy.
- The Academy is located near Sector - 56, Gurugram, Haryana next to village Kadarpur, and can be accessed through NH-08 on Sohna Road. The nearest airport is Indira Gandhi International Airport, New Delhi which is 26 Kms away. The nearest Railway Station is Gurugram at a distance of about 20 Kms on Delhi- Jaipur broad gauge railway line. New Delhi Railway station is also 39 kms away. The nearest Inter-State bus terminal is Gurugram located on NH-08 i.e Delhi - Jaipur Highway and is approx 18 Kms from CRPF Academy.
- A guide route map of Academy from NH-8 is enclosed.

5. **Arrival:** Participants coming for course may directly report at the Participants' Hostel (PH) which is situated within the main Academy campus.

6. **Accommodation and Messing** All participating officers will be accommodated in Participant's Hostel. Participants are advised to strictly adhere to the appropriate dress code in the PH Mess. No Participant will be permitted to stay out of the camp, in hotels etc. without prior approval.

7. **Dress Code**

Participant Officers of the course are required to be appropriately dressed while dining in dining hall. They are advised to bring appropriate and sufficient clothing as per season. Winter clothing will be required from Mid December to March. Light warm clothing is recommended from Mid October to Mid December and summer clothing during April to Mid October.

8. **Recreation and Sports**

Facilities for the following games are available in the Academy: - (a) Basket Ball (b) Lawn Tennis (c) Table Tennis (d) Billiards (e) Volley Ball (f) Badminton (g) Squash

Sports equipment will be provided by the Academy.

9. **Dispersal**

Participants will be permitted to leave after the Valedictory Address in the afternoon on the concluding day of each course. They can leave on the same day by the evening flight/trains/buses. The officers should arrange the return journey reservation in advance. In case of any problem, they should contact the Course Director/ Course Coordinator on their arrival. All

Officers should clear their dues (Mess/Library/Canteen/Lodging etc.) before their departure. Officers may use debit/credit cards, UPI for clearing their dues. Payment by cheque is not accepted.

**10. Miscellaneous :** The Academy will provide Room Boys to Course Participants on sharing basis to take care of their daily needs. Participants are not permitted to bring any type of pets and are advised not to bring arms/ammunition. All officers are expected to maintain strict discipline during the course. The Course Participants may bring their family during the course. However, prior information may be shared with the Academy for making requisite arrangements. On certain occasions due to multiplicity of courses at a time there may be accommodation crunch. Occasions may demand Officers to make their own arrangements of accommodation, in case they bring families. They may make prior telephonic calls for any clarifications.

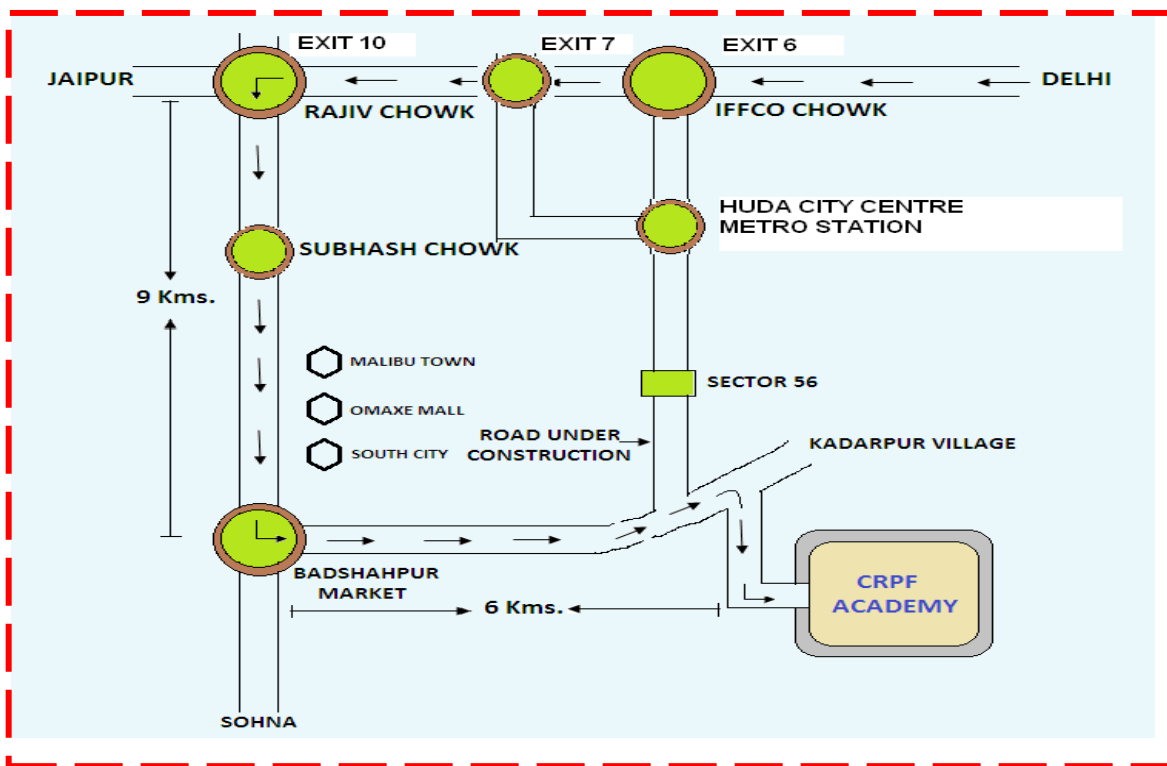
